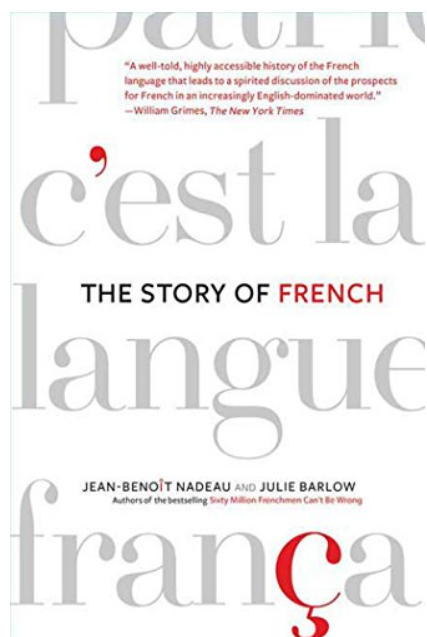

That major historical moments affect a language's development seems to be self-evident. Nadeau and Barlow traveled the world to research what they call the mental universe of French speakers from its center in France to such places as Canada, Senegal and Israel. French carries with it a vision of the State and of political values, a particular set of cultural standards, the authors write. They have managed to corral what could be an ungainly subject—both the history and the present day—in a clearly written, well-organized approach to the lingua franca of millions of people. Francophiles will be well-served by the care and detail with which the authors handle their subject, while English speakers will find an illuminating portrait of Gallic sensibility. Nov. Nadeau and Barlow's history of French is chockablock with these sorts of intriguing facts about the language and its evolution contrary to common belief, English was a major influence on French, not the other way around.
